PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOLS

21st RCBK Interschool Painting Competition (2023-24)

1. Competition will be held in hybrid mode. The preliminary round will be in online mode and final round in offline (in person) mode
2. Participant groups will be as under:
Junior Group: Students studying in std. 6 & 7
Senior Group: Students studying in std. 8 & 9
3. School will identify 5 students from each standard (total 10 students in each group) EITHER by conducting school level competition OR on recommendation of art teacher who will certify that the painting was done by the student concerned within prescribed time limit.





4. Theme of this year's competition is-Poster Painting for "Cultural DIVERSITY in INDIA"

5. Only water-based colours to be used.



6. The painting should be done on A3 size drawing paper.

7. Time duration: Maximum 90 minutes



8. Art teacher or an authorized person will download the registration form available on website www.rcbkpainting.info and upload the scanned copy of duly filled. Registration form on the website will be available from 15 Dec to 22 Dec, 2023.

9. A link will be generated on successful submission of duly filled in registration form.



10. Students' paintings will be uploaded by school authorities in prescribed format from 10 Jan, 2024 to 15 Jan, 2024 on the link provided to the school by the organizers.

11. Please note that slogan/message in the poster should have a maximum of 10 words in either English/Hindi/Marathi/Gujarati language.



12. The word/s has to be in participant's own handwriting using sketch pen. Use of stencil or any other similar accessory is not allowed.

13. From among all entries received from participating schools in respective group, max 300 participants (150 from each group) will be selected for the final round to be held in offline (in person) mode on 26 January, 2024 at Thakur College of Science & Commerce, ThakurVillage, Kandivali East, Mumbai-400101.



14. Names of participants selected for the final round will be published on our website on 20 January, 2024. These participants will have to execute the same art work during the final round in the presence of judges.



15. All participants will receive an e-Participation Certificate after 26 January, 2024.

16. Paintings of the participants selected for final round will be submitted by the school for physical verification, if required by the Judges

17. Further details about final round will be communicated to the short listed participants through the art teacher/ authorized person of the respective school.



18. Three top winners from each group will receive Prize & Merit Certificate.
