PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

01. The competition will be conducted at the venue given in event details.
02. Group Categories & Themes:
 - **Junior Group:** Std. 6 & 7 – Civic Sense
 - **Senior Group:** Std. 8 & 9 – AI and the Future
03. Schools may nominate up to **10 students per group** – 5 students from each standard – either through an internal competition or teacher recommendation.
04. A **Drawing/Art Teacher** should be appointed as the **Single Point of Contact (SPOC)** for all communication and coordination.
05. Schools must download the registration form from www.rcbkpaintingcompetition.com and submit the duly completed group-wise registration forms within the prescribed registration period.
06. All participants must carry a valid **School ID Card** and preferably come in **School Uniform**
07. Only water-based colours are permitted. The use of scales, stencils or other drawing instruments are not allowed.
Paper Size: A3 (will be provided by organisers)
Time Duration: 90 minutes
08. If text is included in the poster:
 - Permitted languages: **English, Hindi or Marathi**
 - Stencils are not permitted
09. All participants will receive **e-Certificates** after the event as part of RCBK's environmentally conscious initiative.
10. Winners will be communicated to the school via email.
11. **Prizes and Merit Certificates** will be awarded to the **Top 3 Winners** in each group at a special felicitation organised by RCBK.
12. The **Champion School Trophy** will be presented to the school achieving the best overall performance based on student winners.
13. **No spot entries** will be accepted.
14. Participant names once registered **cannot be changed on the day of the competition.**
